

Gifted and Talented (GT) Referrals for Students in Grades 1st – 11th Who Are Not Already Identified

The Prosper ISD GT program is designed to provide motivating, challenging experiences that will nurture the unique academic and social-emotional needs of gifted and talented students. Students whose data indicate the advanced program services are the most appropriate educational setting will be recommended for the gifted and talented program.

Students who are already identified and participating in our Prosper ISD Gifted and Talented program do not need to be referred. They will continue to receive GT services.

Students may be referred once every two years. If your child was not referred last year and you would like to refer him/her for GT placement consideration, the referral window for students in grades 1st – 11th is March 3 – 23rd. Referrals must be completed through Infosnap. The link will be live beginning on March 3rd and will be posted on the Gifted and Talented referral [webpage](#):

Referrals must be completed by Thursday, March 23 at 3:00 pm. Late referrals are not accepted.

The first phase of testing for grades 1st - 8th will be on Saturday, April 8 at Folsom Elementary, 800 Somerville Drive, Prosper, TX. Students in grades 9th - 11th will be tested during the school day on campus during the month of April.

Data will be gathered and placement decisions for students will be made by the campus placement committees. Parents will be notified of the results via US mail. Letters will be mailed no later than May 25, 2017. Students recommended for the program will begin participation in the GT program in the fall of the 2017-18 school year.
